

PACKET C

Erosion and Sediment Control for Packet C Projects

The following are required:

- 1) A '**Declaration of Responsibility**' shall be submitted.
- 2) Comply with the provisions and regulations developed by the Permitted Project.
- 3) The applicant must complete a Packet C permit request and pay the applicable fee.
- 4) Installation and maintenance of a stable construction access.
- 5) Avoid disturbing drainage swales if vegetation is established. If drainage swales are bare, install erosion control blankets or sod to immediately stabilize.
- 6) Install drop inlet protection for all inlets on the property.
- 7) Install curb inlet protection, on both sides of the road, for all inlets along property frontage and along the frontage of adjacent lots, or install temporary catch basin inserts in each inlet and frequently clean.
- 8) Contain erosion from any soil stockpiles created on-site with silt fence around the base.
- 9) Installation and maintenance of appropriate perimeter erosion and sediment control measures prior to land disturbance.
- 10) Clean-up of sediment that is either tracked or washed onto roads.
 - A. Bulk clearing of sediments shall not include flushing the area with water.
 - B. Cleared sediment must be redistributed or disposed of in a manner that is in compliance with all applicable statutes and regulations.
- 11) Adjacent lots disturbed by an individual lot operator must be repaired and stabilized with temporary or permanent surface stabilization.
- 12) Unvegetated areas that are scheduled or likely to be left inactive for fifteen (15) days or more must be temporarily or permanently stabilized with measures appropriate for the season to minimize the erosion potential. Vegetated areas with a density of less than seventy percent (70%) shall be restabilized using appropriate methods to minimize the erosion potential.
- 13) Meet the criteria in Rule 5 for final stabilization.

- 14) Need a site plan showing the descriptions for room additions, pole barns, garages, and in-ground pools included below:
 - a. Affected parcel and where project is located on property.
 - b. Dimensions of project (area disturbed and/or structure).
 - c. Show property lines and how far you are building from them.
 - d. Show surface water flow lines, (which way the water flows on property and around the project's location).
 - e. Show what kind of ground cover is around the project, e.g. grass, dirt, rock.
 - f. Show a north arrow.
 - g. Show the access road/construction drive and give details.
- 15) If in a recorded subdivision or minor plat, we need a recorded copy of the plat.
- 16) Applicant/owner will be responsible for this improvement and attest to its location and the accuracy of all the information presented with the Packet C permit request.
